## Background

The work of the Washington DC Police Foundation (the Foundation) started in 2000 when the members of the Federal City Council's Public Safety Committee created the Washington DC Police Fund. This donor-advised fund supported youth, community, and crime-fighting programming until 2007, when the group incorporated as the Washington DC Police Foundation. The Foundation has grown to approximately 60 members and anticipates providing ever-increasing support for public safety programming, awareness, and initiatives in the District of Columbia.

## Our Mission in Action

A sampler of the Foundation's recent activities includes:

### Giving Resources:

- funding MPD programs to keep youth safe and involved in positive activities
- buying protective equipment for officers fighting drugs in the city
- giving vaults and truckloads of donated furniture to MPD for District Stations
- supporting a vulnerable neighborhood with crime-prevention tools
- providing pro bono architectural and construction services to plan a police training village
- donating tickets to sporting and cultural events to MPD for their youth programs and for the Chief to reward officers

### Expanding Public Safety Awareness:

- distributing an informative semi-monthly e-newsletter
- conducting an annual awards luncheon honoring the finest members of MPD
- holding educational Board meetings and tours at various MPD units

### Advancing Public Safety Policy and Initiatives:

- working to advance the District's forthcoming crime lab
- advocating for vehicle theft prevention programs

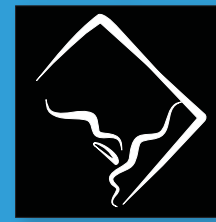

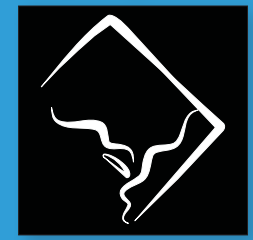
