Safe City CCTV Cameras Installed and Operational

Over a year after the launch of the Safe City project in the Trinidad neighborhood of the Fifth District, nine cameras are mounted and operating, supported by a complex infrastructure to relay visual data back to police headquarters. MPD staff and officers worked diligently with the DDOT, Pepco, community representatives, and others to implement this complex system that promises to deter and capture crimes in that community. Avrio, the company which supplied the cameras, was generously patient and understanding as the process lumbered along.
