



2009 Grants Awarded to MPD

In 2009, the **Washington DC Police Foundation** awarded the following grants to the Metropolitan Police Department as part of our mission to promote public safety by providing financial and in-kind resources to the Chief of Police and the Metropolitan Police Department.

FINANCIAL GRANTS AWARDED

Equipment to Fight PCP

\$68,000

The Foundation was able to respond to the Chief's critical request for support to purchase crime-fighting equipment for the MPD's Major Narcotics Branch to fight the alarming influx of PCP in our city. Thanks to member Terry Golden for helping to raise these funds, and more from the DC business community.

Citywide Outreach in Every Police Beat

\$40,000

Throughout the year, MPD uses this funding to host community events such as summer programs, back-to-school programs, Halloween safe haven events, and more at each District station.

STARS Program

\$20,000

Students Taking Another Route to Success (STARS) is a summer camp program run by MPD School Resource Officers who have identified disadvantaged youth with potential to succeed to participate in the program during the summer months. The camp includes job skills training, math and reading comprehension, drug and gang prevention/resistance skills, courthouse tours and more.

Shop With A Cop

\$15,666

150 children were identified from low-income families to spend the day with an officer on a \$100 shopping spree at the Target DCUSA store.

MPD Wolverines Youth Football and Cheerleading League

\$10,000

Lt. Moses Vines runs this league in MPD's 3rd District neighborhood welcoming all youth to participate in football and cheerleading activities. Funding for the league provides the cost of registration fees for each child as well as equipment, field fees, travel and tournament fees.

Girls Time Out

\$9,000

This grant funded the six month summer program of MPD's Girls Time Out program, a monitoring, mentoring, and educational program where officers work closely with girls 14-17 years of age who have come to the attention of law enforcement.

Visual Language Translation Cards

\$8,000

This grant supported the purchase of Visual Language Translation Cards for the Department. The cards break down language barriers when MPD members assist non-English speaking victims of crimes.

Victims Services Branch Outreach

\$5,000

The MPD Victim Services Branch handles support services to children of homicide victims, domestic violence, and sexual assaults. Funding provided supplies to comfort these children when affected by these circumstances.

Metro Summer Basketball League

\$5,000

This grant supported 3 basketball tournaments with more than 800 participants from rival neighborhoods, which fosters positive and safe social community events through sports.



Outstanding Police Personnel Awards **\$4,000**
As part of the 4th Annual 2009 Washington DC Police Foundation Awards Luncheon, four cash awards were presented to selected outstanding sworn and civilian MPD personnel in front of the Chief and her top command staff, city officials, and Foundation members and guests. The awards went to Officer of the Year, Detective of the Year, Reserve Officer of the Year, and Civilian of the Year.

Women's Council Grant to Youth Program **\$1,500**
At the DC Police Foundation's Women's Council Women's Reception for Chief Lanier, the Women's Council presented a small grant to the Chief for the Department's Girls Time Out program.

Field Day Coins **\$1,250**
Thanks to member donations, the Foundation was able to purchase commemorative coins for the Department's first Field Day in over twenty years.

Step Into Shape Fitness and Weight-loss Challenge **\$500**
This grant supported the kickoff of the Department's summer fitness program to promote healthy eating and regular exercise for the entire Department.
