



## DC Police Foundation 2010 Grants Summary



### GRANTS AWARDED

#### **Community and Youth Programming**

**\$77,301**

Thanks to a local foundation, this grant continues to fund MPD's youth educational and anti-violence programs and grants for each of MPD's District Stations to conduct year-round community events.

#### **College Tour for At-Risk Youth**

**\$45,500**

Thanks to member Motorola for providing this very generous grant to help support MPD's college tours for disadvantaged youth. MPD School Resource Officers conducted 6 tours to local colleges for seventy-two 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students from DC Public Schools and from rivaling neighborhoods.

#### **Girls Time Out**

**\$9,000**

Thanks to the Clark Family Foundation for continuous support of this important program mentoring girls ages 12 to 18. The program focuses on building self-esteem, life skills, and conflict resolution during the school year. It also helps build a positive relationship between the girls and officers.

#### **Youth Advisory Council**

**\$7,500**

Thanks to member Target for supporting this MPD program that engages over 100 students from DC Public Schools. The students are identified by School Resource Officers who have shown good behavior and promise, and are elected into positions on the Council. The program provides exposure to career paths, access to mentors and internships, and skill-building opportunities.

#### **United Way of the National Capital Area (UWNCA) Grant**

**\$18,500**

The Foundation was delighted to receive a matching grant from the UWNCA for MPD youth and community programs, which also include health and fitness training for young participants at MPD's summer camps.

#### **Equipment to Fight PCP**

**\$11,000**

The Foundation raised additional funds in early 2010 to complete the purchase of crime-fighting equipment for MPD's Major Narcotics Branch to fight the influx of the drug PCP in our city. Many thanks to member Terry Golden and local DC businesses for supporting this urgent request from the Chief.

#### **MPD Fire and Family Field Day**

**\$8,450**

The Foundation was able to help support MPD's first Police and Fire Family Field Day in over forty years. It is an important day to celebrate the camaraderie and honor and the history of their service.

#### **National Night Out**

**\$6,000**

Thanks to Target for continuous support of this important annual event that takes place nationwide to strengthen neighborhood spirit and police-community partnerships.

#### **Annual Law Enforcement Awards**
